➤ **Grant Implementation Status**

- **SOURCE WATER PROTECTION GRANT PROGRAM** - Letters and info. packets were sent out to potential steering committee members. Steering committee members include Dr. Amleto Pucci, Kathy Michener, Cindy Unangst, Don Duvall, Ken Beer, and possibly Bill Devlin, along with a representative from each water supplier.
- **DCED LUPTAP GRANT** - BCPC staff are reviewing the second draft. Next it will go to John Wilmer.
- **E. BRANCH WATERSHED DATA INVENTORY** - Completed!
- **WREN GRANT** - Water Awareness Day is set for Saturday, May 7<sup>th</sup> at the Community College. Cindy needs help getting the word out! Presenters include North Penn Water Authority, Sierra Club, Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy, Bucks County Department of Health, Cowan Associates, The PEAK Center, Spotts, Stevens & McCoy, Perkasio Borough Authority, EPA, PA Rural Water, Borton-Lawson, and BCPC.
- **COASTAL NON-POINT POLLUTION PROGRAM (CZM-CNPP)** - data collection has begun. Cindy, Joe and Dennis accompanied Paul for a morning of inventory work. The first progress report was submitted to DEP on April 8<sup>th</sup>.
