➤ **Grant Implementation Status**

- **SOURCE WATER PROTECTION GRANT PROGRAM** - Work is progressing along well. Steering committee meeting was held last week. Still in need of information from some of the water suppliers in order to move forward. PSOC map for everyone to look at.
- **DCED LUPTAP GRANT** - BCPC staff are done editing 2nd draft of the Model Water Resources Management Ordinance. It has been sent to John Wilmer for review.
- **WREN GRANT** - Still working on putting water resource curriculum together for the school district.
- **STORMWATER FACILITY PROJECT (CZM-CNPP, GGG)** - Data collection is done and prioritization list is in draft form. Final plan is due for CZM grant on 3/31/06.
- **NEW COASTAL NON-POINT POLLUTION PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION** - Sent out October 24th. Awards to be announced next summer.
- **DELAWARE ESTUARY GRANT PROGRAM** - application went out July 1st. Funding to be used for a water quality assessment, inventory and monitoring strategy, riparian buffer improvement strategy, and public education. Awards announced in December.
- **GROWING GREENER II** - Next round of GGG's are due to DEP by March 3rd. PACC will be applying for match to CZM grant for stormwater facility retrofit work.

➤ **Educational**

- **Delaware Water Resources Regional Committee meeting** - Cindy, Len Smith and Todd Kincaid spoke to the attendees about the PWRP and implementation projects.

- Continue Source Water Protection grant work.
- Review of Model Water Resources Management Ordinance by John Wilmer.
- Continue Stormwater Facility Inventory grant work.
- Looking into corporate foundations for stream gauge funding. Continue to send letters to Mont Co. businesses. We received a \$5,000 pledge from TEVA and \$100 from Landis.
- Work with schools on water resource curriculum ideas.
