➤ **Grant Implementation Status**

- SOURCE WATER PROTECTION GRANT PROGRAM - Work is progressing along well. A conference call took place on June 7th with the consultants. Water supplier meeting will be held in July or August. Data loggers are being installed in each system.
- DCED LUPTAP GRANT - BCPC staff are reviewing 2nd draft of the Model Water Resources Management Ordinance. Next it will go to John Wilmer. Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement was handed out at the last meeting for review. Discussion of it will take place tonight.
- WREN GRANT - We're still working on putting water resource curriculum together for the school district. Final reports are due July 15th.
- COASTAL NON-POINT POLLUTION PROGRAM (CZM-CNPP) - Data collection is continuing. The first progress report was submitted to DEP on April 8th.
- GROWING GREENER GRANT (for CZM match) - see above.
- DELAWARE ESTUARY GRANT PROGRAM - application is going out in the mail tomorrow. Funding to be used for a water quality assessment, inventory and monitoring strategy, riparian buffer improvement strategy, and public education.

➤ **Educational**

- Source Water Protection brochure distribution - approx. 250 left in inventory; + 600 set aside for water suppliers. The brochure is now featured on WREN's website!!
- PACC Website - E-mail Joe with any ideas on how to make it better. Please consider putting a link to the website on your web page if you haven't done so already.
- A workshop entitled "Working with Municipalities on Water Resource Planning" was presented at the WREN conference in June.
- Riegelsville Borough SWPP steering committee - Dennis will attend meeting next Thursday. Last month he joined them as they toured the well sites.

➤ **Next Steps (July-August)**

- Continue Source Water Protection grant work.
- Continue Model Water Resources Management Ordinance review.
- Continue Stormwater Facility Inventory grant work.
- Looking into corporate foundations for stream gauge funding - letter received back from Home Depot Foundation. We will start sending letters to Mont Co. businesses. We received a \$5,000 pledge from TEVA and \$100 from Landis.
- Work with schools on water resource curriculum ideas.
