➤ **Plan Implementation & Grants Status**

- PWPR Time Line and Grants Status update (spreadsheet). Notice the "C"s !
- DCED LUPTAP GRANT - John Rice will discuss his comments and recommendations on the model water resources ordinance and the intergovernmental cooperative agreement.
- SOURCE WATER PROTECTION GRANT PROGRAM - Paul is pulling together all consultants' rough draft stuff by 6/30. Next Steering Committee meeting in September. Paul and Cindy have begun preparing the draft report. Discuss Todd Kincaid's response to the litigation threat letter from M & M Quarry.
- WREN GRANT - Water resource curriculum for the school district is finished. Should be thinking of a topic for next round of WREN grants (March 2007 application date).
- STORMWATER FACILITY INVENTORY PROJECT (CZM-CNPP, GGG) - Anne Klepfer is sending grant close-out materials to DEP. Joe sent report to Desiree at DEP/Norristown.
- CZM CNPP PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION (Retro-fit Design Project) - Grant was denied by CZM, but a slight possibility that funds might become available.
- GROWING GREENER GRANT APPLICATION (Retro-fit Design Project) - PACC applied for match to CZM grant (above). Sending letter (see handout) to request scaled-down work (one basin instead of two) because of CZM grant denial. Also adding municipal cash match statements of commitment. Awards to be announced by DEP this Summer.
- DELAWARE ESTUARY GRANT PROGRAM - Application submitted 7/1/05 for funds to do the watershed monitoring program. Cindy had sent e-mails and made phone calls to find out why our application was turned down and have not received any responses. (Awards were announced December 2005.)

- Continue Source Water Protection grant work.
- Prepare final documents of the *Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement* and the *Model Water Resources Management and Protection Ordinance* and DCED Grant Close-out Report by July 31th. (BCPC to East Rockhill to DCED)
- Investigate partnering with the Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy (PWC) to find funding for stream gauge installation. Continue to pursue corporate and business donations. (PACC has received a \$5,000 pledge from TEVA and \$100 from Landis Market.)
