➤ **Grant Implementation Status**

- SOURCE WATER PROTECTION GRANT PROGRAM - Work is progressing along well. Water supplier and consultant meetings will be held on November 9th.
- DCED LUPTAP GRANT - BCPC staff are almost done editing 2nd draft of the Model Water Resources Management Ordinance. Next it will go to John Wilmer. Contract with John Wilmer needs to be in place by late October.
- WREN GRANT - Still working on putting water resource curriculum together for the school district.
- COASTAL NON-POINT POLLUTION PROGRAM (CZM-CNPP) - Data collection is done and prioritization list is in draft form. Progress report was sent out October 7th.
- GROWING GREENER GRANT (for CZM match) - see above.
- DELAWARE ESTUARY GRANT PROGRAM - application went out July 1st. Funding to be used for a water quality assessment, inventory and monitoring strategy, riparian buffer improvement strategy, and public education. Awards announced in October.
