- **IMPLEMENTATION DOCUMENT** — Includes *Intergovernmental Cooperative Implementation Agreement*, the *Model Water Resources Management and Protection Ordinance*, John Rice's comment letter, the sample resolution, the sample ordinance (to adopt the ICIA), and the *Bucks County Natural Resource Protection Summary Matrix*. Presented at the September 28th PACC meeting. Bedminster, East Rockhill, and West Rockhill have expressed interest in the ICIA.
