➤ **Grant Implementation Status**

- SOURCE WATER PROTECTION GRANT PROGRAM - Work is progressing along well. Water supplier and consultant meetings will be held in mid to late October.
- DCED LUPTAP GRANT - BCPC staff are almost done reviewing 2nd draft of the Model Water Resources Management Ordinance. Next it will go to John Wilmer. Contract with John Wilmer needs to be in place by late October.
- WREN GRANT - Still working on putting water resource curriculum together for the school district.
- COASTAL NON-POINT POLLUTION PROGRAM (CZM-CNPP) - Data collection is done and prioritization list is in draft form. Progress report is due October 7th.
- GROWING GREENER GRANT (for CZM match) - see above.
- DELAWARE ESTUARY GRANT PROGRAM - application went out July 1st. Funding to be used for a water quality assessment, inventory and monitoring strategy, riparian buffer improvement strategy, and public education. Awards announced in October.

➤ **Educational**

- Source Water Protection brochure distribution - 600 set aside for water suppliers. The brochure is now featured on WREN's website!!

- Continue Source Water Protection grant work.
- Review of Model Water Resources Management Ordinance by John Wilmer.
- Continue Stormwater Facility Inventory grant work.
- Summit CZM grant application for Stormwater Facility Retrofit Design.
- Looking into corporate foundations for stream gauge funding. Continue to send letters to Mont Co. businesses. We received a \$5,000 pledge from TEVA and \$100 from Landis.
- Work with schools on water resource curriculum ideas.
